


What's COMNAP's Objective/Purpose?

To develop and promote best practice in managing the support of scientific research in Antarctica.

COMNAP / FARO Similarities

- Our Membership base
 - 15 of 20 FARO countries also participate in ATCMs
 - Of those 15, only four of the member organisations are not the same for both memberships
 - There are four delegates (points of contact) to FARO that are also the usual delegates to COMNAP

 - Providing expert advice





COMNAP / FARO Dissimilarities

- Arctic vs Antarctic obvious geographic differences
- Arctic vs Antarctic obvious governance differences
- COMNAP membership is organisations (National Antarctic Programs are the members) not countries
- COMNAP has recognised status within the Antarctic Treaty System – provides us with a conduit to input practical and technical expert advice directly into the governance system based on first-hand Antarctic knowledge
