The 4th [EU-PolarNet](#) General Assembly took place on March 27 -28 in Tallinn, Estonia, where representatives of about 30 institutions from across Europe discussed how to effectively develop the Integrated European Polar Research Programme.

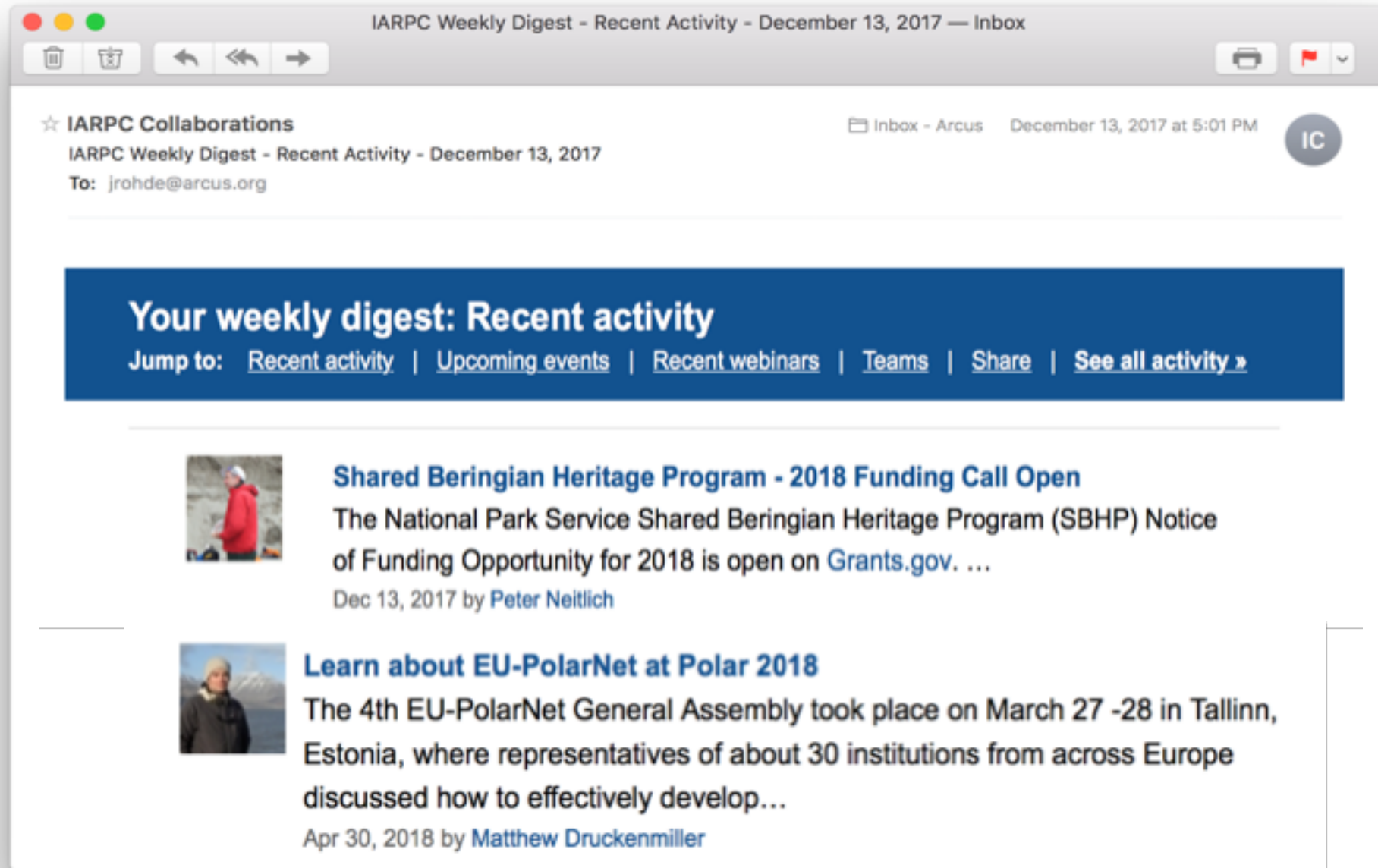
